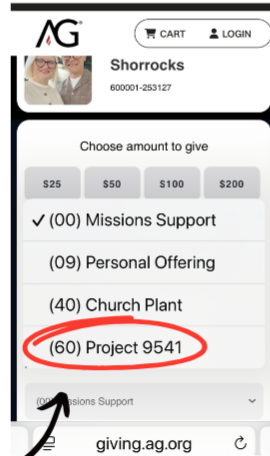

700 MIAST...A NEW HUB!

700 Miast (700 Cities) is the church planting initiative we partner with in Poland. This movement is overseen by the leadership of the Polish Pentecostal Fellowship, with pastors managing the various training "hubs" across the country.

The Vision

The goal is to establish at least one Gospel preaching church in all of the 660 cities in Poland that still do not have access to the Good News of Jesus Christ. **Polish national pastors planting Polish speaking churches.** To do this we will need training hubs in all seven regions of Poland. Currently four regions in Poland have training hubs.

Current Hubs

Presently, there are four active hubs located in:

- **Olesno**
- **Warsaw**
- **Głogów**
- **Kraków** (The newest hub, led by Zbigniew (Zibi) Marzec)
